- Upgrading to a restricted byway part of definitive footpath N 1/21 from approximately ST 8443 2310 south-eastwards to approximately ST 8467 2296.
- Adding a restricted byway from approximately ST 8467 2296 to approximately ST 8498 2271.
- Upgrading to a restricted byway part of definitive footpath N 1/36 from approximately ST 8498 2271 to approximately ST 8503 2269.
- Adding a restricted byway from approximately ST 8503 2269 to Breach Common at approximately ST 8524 2260.
